## Operations Resource

Acute Simple <ul> <li>&lt; 3 months duration</li> <li>&lt; 4 same or similar episodes/lifetime</li> <li>Single region</li> <li>No neurological involvement</li> <li>Chronic Simple</li> <li>Repetitious episodes, &gt;4/lifetime</li> <li>&gt;3 months duration, present complaint</li> <li>Single area of complaint</li> <li>Co-morbidity</li> <li>Work or recreational limitations</li> <li>Failed interventions</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Excellent prognosis</li> <li>Short program of care</li> <li>Pain relief</li> <li>Avoid: chronicity, kinesiophobia, inactivity</li> <li>Release from care at conclusion</li> <li>Moderate prognosis, moderate care program</li> <li>Pain control or elimination</li> <li>Functional restoration</li> <li>Self care strategies and methods</li> <li>Conditioning, body awareness</li> <li>Medication decrease or elimination</li> <li>Release to prn care at plateau</li> </ul>
Acute Complex      < 3 months duration     <4 same or similar episodes/lifetime     Single region     Disc signs/symptoms     Neurological/nerve root involvement	<ul> <li>Moderate prognosis, moderate care program</li> <li>Avoidance of surgery</li> <li>Avoid: chronicity, kinesiophobia, inactivity, complications</li> <li>Centralization of pain</li> <li>Pain control</li> <li>Release to prn care at conclusion</li> </ul>
Chronic Complex  Repetitious episodes, >4/lifetime  >3 months duration, present complaint  Co-morbidity  Work or recreational limitations  Failed interventions  Multiple areas of complaint  Neurological/nerve root involvement	<ul> <li>Poor prognosis, lengthy program of care</li> <li>Functional improvement, restoration</li> <li>Pain control</li> <li>Return to work</li> <li>Self-care strategies</li> <li>Decrease inactivity, kinesiophobia, pain behaviors, medication use</li> <li>Tapering program of care, release to supportive care at plateau</li> </ul>
